CHAMPAGNE

The Champagne wine region (archaic English: Champany) is a historic province within the Champagne administrative province in the northeast of France. The area is best known for the production of the sparkling white wine that bears the region's name. EU law and the laws of most countries reserve the term «Champagne» exclusively for wines that come from this region located about 100 miles (160 km) east of Paris. The viticulture boundaries of Champagne are legally defined and split into five wine producing districts within the administrative province: Aube, Côte des Blancs, Côte de Sézanne, Montagne de Reims, and Valley de la Marne. The towns of Reims and Épernay are the commercial centers of the area.

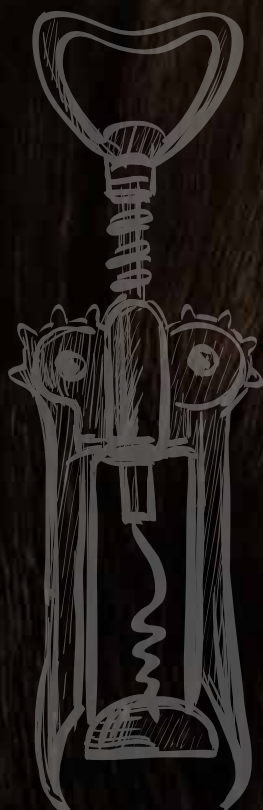

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SPAIN

Spanish wines are produced in the southwestern European country of Spain. Located on the Iberian Peninsula, Spain has over 2.9 million acres (over 1.17 million hectares) planted making it the most widely planted wine producing nation however it is only the third largest producer of wine in the world coming after Italy and France. This is due, in part, to the very low yields and wide spacing of the old vines planted on the dry infertile soil found in many Spanish wine regions.

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SOUTH AFRICA

South African wine has a history dating back to 1659, and at one time Constantia was considered one of the greatest wines in the world. Access to international markets has unleashed a burst of new energy and new investment. Production is concentrated around Cape Town, with major vineyard and production centers at Paarl, Stellenbosch and Worcester. There are about 60 appellations within the Wine of Origin (WO) system, which was implemented in 1973 with a hierarchy of designated production regions, districts, and wards. WO wines must be made 100% from grapes from the designated area.

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GERMANY

Among enthusiasts, Germany's reputation is primarily based on wines made from the Riesling grape variety, which at its best is used for aromatic, fruity, and elegant white wines that range from very crisp and dry to well-balanced, sweet and enormous aromatic concentration. The proportion of German vineyards devoted to the cultivation of dark-skinned grape varieties has now stabilized at slightly more than a third of the total surface. For the red wines, Spatburgunder, the domestic name for Pinot noir, is in the lead.

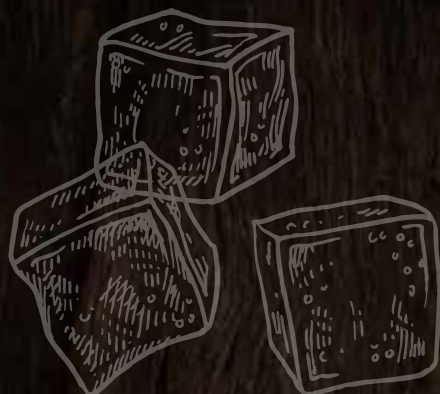
